Copyright:

The format is: Copyright (publication year, i.e. 2000) by Author/Publisher.
You can use the symbol © in place of the word "Copyright" if you wish.
Your book is protected by this act alone, but if you wish more official registration you can call the Register of Copyrights at: 202-207-9100 and ask for form TX, and Circular R1, *Copyright Basics*; and R2, *Publications of the Copyright Office*.

Country of Origin:

You must put "Printed in China" (or Canada) on your copyright page for the books to clear US customs. There are no duties on books. If you print the name and address of your publishing company on the back cover of your book, you must also print "Printed in China" underneath the address. Otherwise, it is not mandatory you print the country of origin on the jacket or jacket flap.

Printer Acknowledgement:

It is customary to add a credit line on the copyright page for the printer which should read: Printed in China by Everbest Printing Co. through Four Colour Imports, Ltd., Louisville, Kentucky.
